

## James C Maguire December 17, 1941 - April 8, 2019

James C. Maguire, 77, of Wheeling died at Ohio Valley Medical Center on Monday, April 8th, 2019, surrounded by his family after a year long battle with Cholangio carcinoma.

He was born in Martins Ferry, Oh on December 17, 1941, the son of the late William H. Maguire and Clara V. (Bell) Maguire.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by a daughter Jamie Sue (Maguire) Donovan, a brother William H. Maguire, and a sister Evada (Maguire) Jones.

He is survived by his wife of 52 years, Mary E. (Burkle) Maguire, a son William J. (Brandy Taggart) Maguire of Wheeling, WV, grandchildren: Jayma and Joseph Donovan both of Columbus, Oh, Chelsea (Allen Howard) Maguire, Emily (Brandon Bunting) Maguire, James C. Jim is also survived by a sister, Jane (Maguire) Gordon of Powhatan Point, Oh, a brother, David H. (Barb Beavon) Maguire of Martins Ferry, Oh, several nieces and nephews along with his three Miniature Schnauzers (Mags, Nanook and Kandee).

Jim was a member of St. Paul Evangelical Lutheran Church in Bridgeport, Oh, a member of the Ranch Sportsman Club, Inc., a life member of the Ohio County Wildlife League, DAV, VFW Post 626 Bellaire, Oh and the American Legion Post 0038 Martins Ferry, OH.

Jim was retired from Wheeling Pittsburgh Steel Corp. and worked at both the Culvert and Beech Bottom Plants, A proud Veteran of the United States Marine Corps and a Vietnam Veteran.
